## TENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT CONFERENCE

The Annual Conference of the Tenth Judicial Circuit will be held this year in the United States District Courtroom in the Post Office Building at Denver on July 19th, 20th, and 21st. *Dicta* has been asked to announce that all members of the Bar are cordially invited and urged to attend.

The first session commencing at 10:00 A.M. on July 19th will feature addresses on "The Federal Youth Correction Act" with the Honorable Bolitha J. Laws discussing the Act from the viewpoint of the Trial Judge and the Honorable James V. Bennett discussing it from the viewpoint of its Administrators. The 2:00 P.M. session on July 19th will begin with an address by the Honorable Will Shafroth entitled "Judicial Statistics as an Aid to Court Administration" which will be followed by discussion. The morning session on July 20th will be devoted to a discussion of certain proposals to change existing law with respect to jurisdiction and venue. The session on the afternoon of July 20th will feature an address by the Honorable Eugene Rice entitled "Efficient Administration in the District Courts With Respect to Jurors and Witnesses". At the morning session on July 21st committees' reports will be heard with the Honorable Orié L. Phillips presiding.

The lighter side of the program will include a performance of "Beautiful Galatea" at Central City on the evening of July 19th and a cocktail hour and banquet at the University Club on the evening of July 20th.
